**MESSAGE FROM THE CANADIAN HELLENIC CONGRESS'
PRESIDENT AND NATIONAL COUNCIL ON THE OCCASION OF
THE 201ST ANNIVERSARY OF GREECE'S INDEPENDENCE,
MARCH 25TH 1821**
